

The IDG is a legalised non-profit(1) religious association. It is solely self-funded via donations. That is to say, the IDG does not ask for any sort of regular quota from its members nor we accept any kind of public aid or tax benefit. Donations can be either direct or produced through merchandise, listed on <u>our website</u>.

Therefore anyone can decide freely whether or not help the IDG with its regular expenses and future projects (2).

- (1) "Non-profit" means that there is no economic benefit, neither personal nor collective, and that all received funds are simply used to guarantee the survival and effective functioning of the organisation.

(2) Where does all the money go?

- Internet: It has its expenses (domains, space, etc). We would like to purchase new domains, server space and eliminate the automatic ads placed by the current host.
- Legal costs: The official registration of our association incurred in costly postal and notarial services. Likewise, any further legal modification or administrative contact requires more notarial expenses, certified mail, etc.
- Cult material and travel: To be used in all sort of rites. Some materials are inexpensive yet they need to be replaced on a regular basis. Some other materials need to be bought only in the rare occasion, but they can be quite expensive. Also, not all rites are celebrated in the same place, resulting in transportation expenses.
- Merchandising: There is a number of ideas for new items. Nevertheless, printing tests and first orders must be paid in advance.
- Social work: Individual members of the IDG have helped and donated to a number of different causes. Now, the IDG would like to contribute in a significant way to some humble small groups which, we consider, have been carrying out serious, honest and hard work for a long time. Namely, we are referring to animal welfare, cultural and environmental associations (with no formal relationship with us whatsoever).
- Future: We dream of having our own space (a *Nemeton I* temple) with basic facilities where to welcome our members and friends in the celebration of rites, gatherings, etc. Hopefully a place where we could leave our physical remains to rest after being welcomed by God Berobreo. We dream of having at least one full-time dedicated staff member.
